Development Team Assistant Coach Job Description

The CCST Development Team consists of primarily late elementary and middle school age skiers (11-14 years old) interested in exploring ski racing and having fun on skis. The head coach will bring knowledge of the fundamentals of skill development/training and must enjoy working with middle-school-age kids.

This is the transition for Ski Tigers from once-a-week meetings to skiing more frequently and learning more about racing. The team meets for dryland training starting in November and continues on snow from late November through March or early April, typically two days a week after school and on Saturday mornings. The emphasis is on skill development, an introduction to waxing and racing, and having fun on snow.

Coaching Responsibilities

- Create an atmosphere that U12 and U14 athletes find inviting, exciting, fun, and cool
- Conduct the program within age appropriate guidelines for training and racing
- Assess and improve skiers' classic and freestyle cross-country ski techniques
- Work with head coach to develop and implement the drills and goals of each practice session
- Provide for race-day athlete support and waxing support (at times in conjunction with Competition Team coaches)
- Attend ongoing coaching education/training when available
- Attend and help coach at local Thanksgiving and Christmas camps

Requirements

- Ability to relate well, engage and lead U12 and U14 aged skiers.
- Ability to teach classic and freestyle cross-country ski techniques to athletes from 11-14 years old with varied skiing and athletic backgrounds, including new skiers
- Experience with waxing and preparation of skis for kick and glide
- Strong leadership and organizational skills
- Effective verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to work well with other coaches, athletes, and parents
- Be responsible, reliable and punctual

Desired Qualification

- Certification as a USSA coach at the 100-level or higher (or willingness to become certified)
- Experience working with middle school students and athletes
- Experience with cross-country ski racing

Compensation and benefit

- Stipend rate set annually by the CCST Board of Directors
- US Ski and Snowboard Coach/Official annual membership
- Continuing education support from the CCST

The Development Team head coach, along with all other Development and Competition Team coaches for the Copper Country Ski Tigers, are subject successful completion of SafeSport certification and background checks in the time and manner specified by the CCST Board of Directors.
